

## **Coaches and Managers final preparation for the season.**

Just some quick points for your information relating to final preparations for your first game.

- You should have issued all players with a copy of the draw
- All Mini and Junior players have been allocated their training ball.
- You should have your jerseys and your match balls
- You should have your arm bands for Coaches and Managers
- One person from each team has been issued the Official GHFA Information Booklet (Green cover)
- From U9 up you need to follow the new procedure for Checking the ID cards of the other team. (Refer Attached)
- For U9 up, your Age Co-ordinator will have given you a supply of Official Team Sheets to be completed on match day. (you provide sheet for each home game)
- If you are playing at North Ryde Oval then you need to work with us to provide parents to assist in the Canteen.
- If you are the first or last NRSC Mini's team playing at Magdala then you need to dress or undress the Small Sided Game fields (4 of them). This is very easy and the equipment will be there for you.
- You should issue your players / parents with the Wet Weather process. Steer them first to the GHFA website, then to the relevant Council phone number, depending on the location of the relevant ground.
- You need to inform our Scorer of your result as per the following. We need this communicated by 6pm on the day of the match.
